






BOOK SPOTLIGHT

"This is Your Brain on Sports" by Wertheim and Sommers (2016) provides rich insight about perception, expectations, and behaviors as it relates to the sporting culture we live in today. The authors explore explore culture change and dynamics at play when it comes to sports and individual reactions to teams, rules, etc. The causal tone and many personal jokes are a bit overdone, but they also provide nuggets to chew on later. For example, the IKEA effect is mentioned a few times, which means that "people inflate their valuations of self-made products" (p. 151). The authors continue ramble with opinion, and bias, in their comments. If you can make it through all that, the takeaways provide some fresh ideas about the behaviors and mindsets that continue to be shaped by a sports-crazy culture.

Lymph system helps remove excess fluids from body tissues.


Helps with absorption of fatty acids and subsequent transport of fat, chyle, to the circulatory system.
